A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT THE 3rd YEAR OF A THREE YEAR 421 STATE CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FUND GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION

- WHEREAS, On, April 7, 2009, the City Council approved Agenda Item 09-198 authorizing the application and acceptance of 421 State Criminal Justice Planning Funds to fund a Child Abuse Investigator position at 100% in Year 1, 80% in Year 2, and 60% in Year 3, based on the availability of funding; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney that the Child Abuse Investigator grant be implemented during the 2011-2012 fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council designates the Interim City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the submission of the grant application for Year 3 of the Child Abuse Investigation grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
