 on November 30, 2015, Officer Messner serving as a School Resource Officer, was out front of Evans Middle School doing a morning traffic detail at the crosswalk for her campus Principal, Mr. Todd Young; and
 WHEREAS,
 Officer Messner was crossing students as she saw a vehicle entering the carpool line drive up on the curb near the gym, Officer Messner told the children walking near the gym to run and get out of the car's path; and
 WHEREAS,
 when Officer Messner noticed that the driver had passed out and was not responding, she ran to the vehicle and attempted to get the kids out of the way and was able to jump through the driver's side open window and turn the steering wheel towards the street to avoid the children in the crosswalk and parked cars in the handicap area; and

 Officer Messner got to the floorboard and was attempting to hit the brake when the female began coming to and pressed the gas pedal. Officer Messner was dragged approximately 10 feet before she was able to hit the brake with her hand and was able to stop the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Officer Messner has dedicated over nine years of unselfish service to the citizens of McKinney and through Officer Messner's work with the children of McKinney, she is affectionately referred to as "Officer Mo"; and
