Chairman Dixon called for any citizen comments and there were none.

Chairman Dixon called for any Board, MCDC Liaison, or Director Comments: Director Kowski noted that Parks Maintenance repaired the lawn at EA Randles Park and MISD should repair their portion of the land. He also informed the Board of the vandalism at Fitzhugh Park that is being repaired. A reminder was given about the Public Input meeting at Old Settler's Recreation Center on December 19th. An update on the Wonder event was given: the opening weekend sold 800 tickets; the next weekend shows 1,000 more tickets sold; more vendors are signing up due to the growth and popularity; and Cottonwood Park will begin construction at the end of January.

Board members unanimously approved the motion by Board member Kelvin Thomas, seconded by Board member Sean Nance to adjourn at 5:27pm.
