Ray Turco presented his proposal ideas on Target Market Study:

The objective of the study is to gather more accurate and up-to-date information that will

assist MCVB staff to target promotional and advertising spending more effectively.

After Mr. Turco presented his ideas, there was discussion on how to go about getting

the results the CVB Board wants to accomplish. The committee decided that there will

be 2 surveys, one for business/corporate and the other for leisure. Each of the

Development Committee members will submit questions on what type of items they

would like addressed in the survey so that Mr. Turco can identify the questions that will

be used in the survey. The survey is to be no longer than one page. Mr. Turco will

collect 400 surveys within a one week time period and depending on what hotel has

generated the most taxable receipts (percentage) is how it will be divided on how many

surveys each of the hotel used will have to administer in the one week time period.

Executive Director Guerra will approach each of the hotels to see if they would like to

participate with the understanding that we will share the information gathered for their

hotel. Mr. Turco will then send a letter to the hotel participants and ask them to administer X amount of surveys per day. The hotels will be asked to see if they would like to participate on the following grounds: each desk clerk that gets a survey filled out by a guest will receive a \$2.00 incentive and they will hand the guest that takes the survey a \$5.00 gift card.
