A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT, THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, TO RENOVATE THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING TO INCLUDE A TRAINING ROOM

- **WHEREAS**, the primary goal of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant is to meet the firefighting and emergency response needs of fire departments; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Assistance to Firefighters Grant through the Department of Homeland Security, provides funding to update safety and protective equipment; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney to update safety and protective equipment for citizens and firefighters; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, designates the City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, and terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

- Section 1 The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves the acceptance of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant, if awarded.
