

General Order/Policy Changes

There are four Police Department policies governed by City Council Resolution: 1) Hiring; 2) Promotional Procedures; 3) Personnel Complaints Investigations; and 4) Corrective Measures. The Chief of Police is proposing changes to two of them: Promotional Procedures and Personnel Complaints Investigations. These changes are supported by the McKinney Police Association and the McKinney Fraternal Order of Police.

Highlights

Promotional Procedures

- 1. Provides for the gradual elimination of the Corporal rank
- 2. Changes minimum qualifications for Police Sergeant to 4 years of sworn service
- 3. Requires Assistant Chief appointees to possess a Bachelor's degree and Master Peace Officer certification.
- 4. Prior to looking outside the department for candidates for a position, the Chief may open an assessment process to the next lower rank level if an insufficient pool of candidates is not available at the eligible rank level.
- 5. Requires a minimum 90 day notice of the source list for a written exam.
- 6. Stipulates that appointment to the rank of Deputy Chief or Assistant Chief is by direct appointment of the Chief of Police.

Personnel Complaints Investigations

Allows the chain of command to delay making disciplinary recommendations to the Chief of Police until after the completion of the disciplinary hearing.

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
