
Discussion of City-Owned Properties in Downtown






On May 7, 2013, the City Council unanimously voted to indefinitely table action on the Downtown RFP (case #13-081M) in order to fully identify and discuss issues prior to entering into a public-private partnership(s) to redevelop City-owned properties downtown.

Outstanding Issues/Concerns:

- 1. What residential density is appropriate for Downtown McKinney?
- 2. What downtown site is best suited to accommodate a future municipal building(s)?
- Resolution to the Gateway project is necessary prior to moving forward with the redevelopment of City-owned properties downtown.
