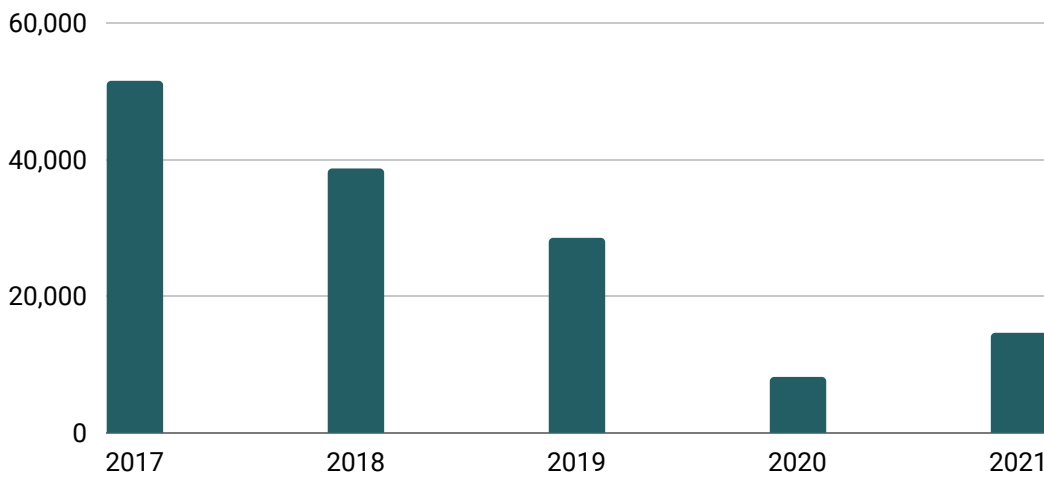

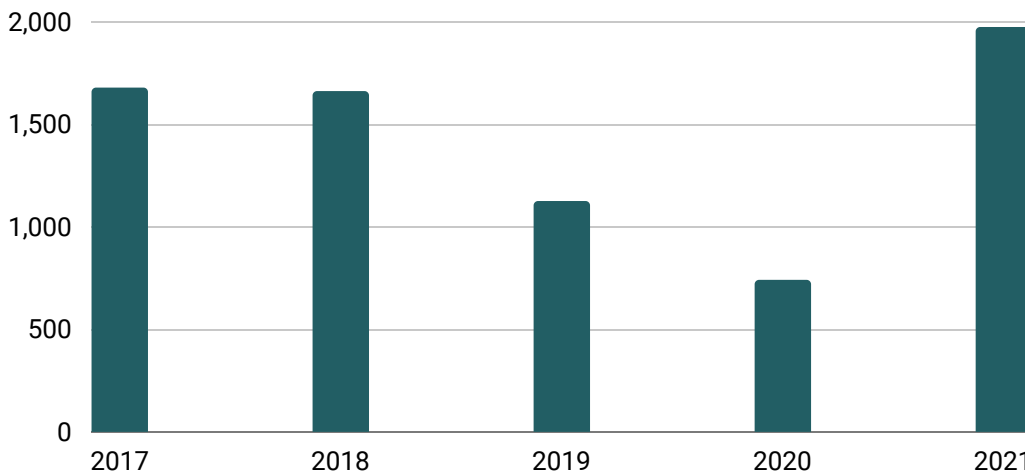
# By the Numbers

FY 21 saw overall program attendance numbers rebound from FY20, but flatline at 51% of 2019 attendance and only reach 28% of our program attendance peak year of 2017.



**Total Program Attendance by Fiscal Year.**

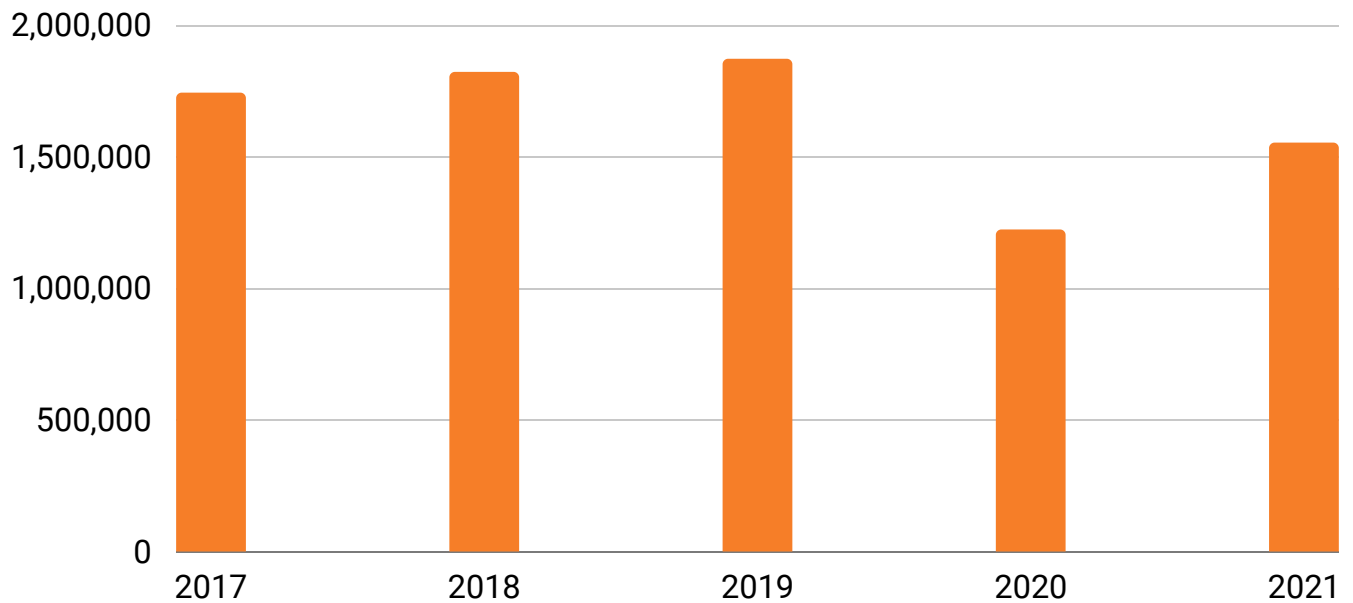
However, Teen program attendance is the highest it has ever been in McKinney- 18% higher than the previous peak from 2017!

**TOTAL CIRCULATIONS BY FISCAL YEAR**

FY 21 total circulations recovered somewhat from a pandemic level circulation of 2020, reaching 83% of of FY 19 totals.

Overall, library visits were down vs FY 19, but we fulfilled over 2,000 hold requests per week in FY 21, 18% more than in 19. The average person who placed a request for an item in FY21 did so 19 times, vs 14 times in 2019.
