## **Economic Development**

- Staff is continuously working with Project Red River executives, City Manager, MEDC President and Legal Counsel to move the project forward.
- President Auterson, Business Retention & Expansion (BREP) Director Valencia, Business Development Specialist Clark and Staff had a hard-hat tour at 2 Greenside at Craig Ranch under construction with two leasing agents. This Class A three-story office building will add 48,421 sq. ft. to McKinney office space inventory and is estimated to be completed in the second quarter of 2017. (Photo attached)
- Staff has worked with Joseph Hsu, Wistron GreenTech General Manager to brainstorm the concept of a private-public partnership of Wistron McKinney Technology Campus to recruit more Taiwanese businesses to McKinney as well as to increase the Wistron office spaces occupancy when available. To recruit businesses from Asia and Europe is incorporated with the international market strategy of MEDC Strategic Planning under work and upon approval.
- Under President Auterson's leadership, Staff joined the team to attend TadZo Strategic Planning Initiative Work Sessions on April 26, 27 and 28.
- Assistant City Manager Shelton and Staff co-hosted a meeting with Development Services staff to discuss the industrial land infrastructure requirements to attract new businesses to McKinney. This meeting was inspired by the specific land interest indicated by Project Forest and led to the discussion of additional available land infrastructure capabilities in the City.

#### **Business Retention and Expansion**

 Staff planned a lunch meeting with Service First Mortgage (SFM) President and Executive Team for its first anniversary being a McKinney corporate citizen on June 21. City Manager Grimes and MEDC President Auterson will join the lunch meeting. This meeting will offer the opportunity for the City of McKinney and MEDC to express our appreciation for SFM and offer the communications channel to better service our existing business.
