

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



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Status:

- ✓ Land is under contract. Expected closing is February 2021.
- ✓ Property has been rezoned City Council approved zoning on December 2, 2020
- ✓ Site Plan has been submitted to the City of McKinney
- ✓ Civil engineering plans are approximately 80% complete
- ✓ Architectural Plans are underway
- ✓ Construction to occur in 2021
- ✓ BancorpSouth (BCS) has committed to providing the project funding to construct the two buildings (\$1.9 mm)
- ✓ Sanchez Charities, LLC / Martin and Kim Sanchez will collateralize the debt
- ✓ Cost of on-site "horizontal" development is \$343,917.00
