

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR OVERTIME TRAFFIC SAFETY ENFORCEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, desires to ratify the City Manager's acceptance of a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant for fiscal year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the home rule charter of the City of McKinney, Texas, designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate grant agreements on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney will provide all required matching funds under said STEP Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directs that in the event of loss or misuse of the Texas Department of Transportation STEP funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Department of Transportation in full pursuant to the terms of the STEP Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves this Resolution ratifying the City Manager's application for and acceptance of, if awarded, a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant for Fiscal Year 2023 from the Texas Department of Transportation for overtime traffic safety enforcement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of its passage and is so resolved.
