A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013, A SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) COMPREHENSIVE GRANT, IF AWARDED, FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, designates the City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency, and
- WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Department of Transportation funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Department of Transportation in full; and
- **WHEREAS**, the STEP Comprehensive grant pays overtime for traffic officers to increase enforcement and adjudication of traffic safety-related laws, and
- **WHEREAS**, the City has been a recipient of the grant since 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the application for and acceptance of Fiscal Year 2013 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Comprehensive grant, if awarded, from the Texas Department of Transportation.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
