Monthly Highlights:

Greens were cut to remove excess thatch and top dressed with sand

Tuesday Night Scrambles averaging 54 participants weekly

• Events:

On July 2nd, the North Texas Junior PGA Ewing Tour visited Oak Hollow along with 75 junior golfers from across the Metroplex. Juniors, Boys and Girls, competed in 4 different age groups. Youngsters and beginners played a nine hole event. More experienced players competed over 18 holes.

The Richardson Senior Golfer Association travels and plays municipal courses throughout the North Texas area. In July, they visited Oak Hollow with over 50 players. The "most senior" of the group is 84 years young. It should be noted that Oak Hollow is in their rotation two times per year.

In late July, we held our second Get Golf Ready tournament. To play, participants must have attended one the previously held Get Golf Ready classes. These tournaments are an excellent opportunity for new players to play in a Scramble/Best-ball event with folks of similar skill level. The tournament format replicates those typically used in corporate outings and fund raising events. We had 35 participants that braved 100 degree heat for the nine hole event.

The OHTPA held it's annual Red, White, and Blue tournament this month in celebration of July 4^{th} . A unique format, where players play six holes from the Red tees, six holes from the White tees and six holes from the Blue tees. Strategy is key, because players get to choose which holes they will play from each tee box. The only limitation is that they play six of each.
