### **ITEM SUMMARY:**

 The proposed resolution authorizes the City to enter into a contract to purchase approximately 298 acres of land south of US 380 and east of the East Fork Trinity River.

- This property was originally identified in the 2003 Parks Strategic Plan as a portion of the west portal at US380 and the East Fork Trinity River.
- This property would provide contiguous City owned floodplain for the planned Trinity River hike and bike trail.
- The requested amount is not to exceed a total of \$1,863,760.
