2012-13 Season Final Report Narrative

McKinney Repertory Theater's Young Actors Guild (YAG) performed five shows this 2012-2013 season. All performances were held at the McKinney Performing Arts Center with the exception of 'Competition Piece.'

In October we performed two one-act plays, 'She Was Only A Farmer's Daughter', a melodrama, and 'Who Murdered Who?', a murder mystery comedy where no one was murdered.

In February we performed Shakespeare's tragedy 'Macbeth.' This three hour production was performed in black and white, a unique experience for the actors and audience.

We were scheduled to produce Tom Stoppard's 'Rosencrantz & Guildenstern Are Dead' in May, but with casting difficulties due to scheduling conflicts with school productions, it was delayed until July and only three performances were done due to a scheduling conflict by MPAC.

In August we performed our Aesop's (Oh So Slightly Updated) Fables, geared to the younger performers in YAG.

'Competition Piece', a comedy about different high school theatre groups preparing to perform Shakespeare plays for a play competition was performed at MPAC for YAG members and parents in early June before 17 actors and production staff and three chaperones traveled to Odessa to participate in the annual Texas Non-profit Theatre Association's Youth Convention. Once again YAG was recognized for an "Outstanding Performance" and for the second year in a row YAG performers won the 'Best Improvisation Award" of the 19 youth theatres participating.

Artistically, it was a very successful year for the Young Actors Guild. We continue to maintain a roster of 70-plus members, many who have been members for years. We did

fall slightly short in our projected income in ticket sales and corporate income, an issue we are addressing for next season.
