

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-MM-____ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND AMEND THE BUDGET IF FUNDED, AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT, THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, TO PURCHASE CARDIAC MONITORS/DEFIBRILLATORS AND SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS TO REPLACE EQUIPMENT THAT DOES NOT MEET CURRENT NFPA STANDARDS

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant is to meet the firefighting and emergency response needs of fire departments; and

WHEREAS, the Assistance to Firefighters Grant through the Department of Homeland Security, provides funding to update safety and protective equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney to update safety and protective equipment for citizens and firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, designates the City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, and terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the submission of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant, and acceptance of award and amendment of budget, if funded.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
