As per your request I am submitting this letter as my letter of intent regarding the remodeling project at 109 East Virginia Street, McKinney, Texas.

The upper story of the building will have EFIS materials for the top of the building and surrounding the windows with a smooth finish as shown on the drawing. The plaster surface will be smoothed and painted over in Antique White. The colors for the EFIS will be a combination of Water Chestnut, Roast Almond, and Master Piece Tan. These are basically tone on tone colors.

The windows of the upper story will be high efficiency wooden divided lights. The glass transoms will be replaced with new clear glass and trimmed in wood painted Chocolate.

The store front will be true divided light windows of clear glass and wood (if the divided light windows are approved). In London, Paris, Rome and other European cities I have visited, apothecary stores such as mine often have divided lights as their store front windows. This is historically correct application for this type of business. McKinney has never had a true apothecary store until my shop opened six years ago. I am trying to expose women to a by-gone era of elegance that is not so commercial.

The front doors will be glass and wood with appropriate kick plate. All wood on the front of the store will be painted Chocolate.

The awning will be of striped canvas materials in Chocolate and Aqua with the store name, "Sharla's" in the center.
