RESOLUTION NO. 2011-MM-___(R)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT THE 3rd YEAR OF A THREE YEAR JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION.

- WHEREAS, On, May 5, 2009, the City Council approved Agenda Item 09-241 authorizing the application and acceptance of a Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant to fund a part-time staff position, based on the availability of funding, to assist in implementing a Community Service Program; and
- **WHEREAS,** the grant provides funding at 100% in Year 1, 80% in Year 2, and 60% in Year 3,
- WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney that the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention grant be implemented during the 2011-2012 fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the Interim City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas approves the submission of the grant application for Year 3 of the Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
