FY 2020-2021, Proposed CDBG-CV Activities

Tele-Health Program - \$ 20,000

City program, assistance to low to moderate income residents and senior citizens with health care services mobile or fixed to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. Service support from the McKinney Fire Department and the Wellness Center for Older Adults. Program will provide services at mobile and fixed locations, providing testing, diagnosis, and other services; and to increase the capacity and availability of targeted health services for infectious disease response within existing health facilities.

- McKinney Fire Department: \$ 10,000
- Wellness Center for Older Adults, \$10,000

Emergency Living Assistance Program: \$ 1,218,992

Program providing direct services and program delivery for emergency rental, mortgage, and utility assistance, excluding water for McKinney for low-to-moderate income residents within city limits, under 0-80% HUD Collin County Guidelines, with up to three months (3) of assistance. Assistance paid directly to service providers. Food and water assistance are not eligible.

Applicants will apply for assistance through the following subrecipient agencies:

- Two agencies, \$ 596,974 each
- CDBG-CV Grant Administration, \$ 25,044

Home Repair Program: \$ 401,328

To meet the needs of McKinney residents, a portion of funds will be used for home repair services for eligible McKinney single-family homeowners. Priority within zip code 75069.
