Evening on Broadway Friday, March 22, 2013 McKinney Performing Arts Center 7:30 PM

The event funded by the City of McKinney Arts Commission was presented on Friday evening, March 22nd at 7:30 PM. The performance was entitled "Evening On Broadway" and was presented in the McKinney Performing Arts Center Courtroom Theater. Over 100 singers, which represent all three of the choruses associated with the Children's Chorus of Collin County organization, shared a variety of music from Broadway Musicals. Our featured guest for the evening was Danny Ray, who represented the North Texas Chapter of the American Theater Organ Society. Throughout the concert, Mr. Ray performed creative organ arrangements to well-known songs from musicals such as Phantom of the Opera, Little Mermaid, The Sound of Music, Annie Get your Gun and more. To be able to feature not only the choral music of Broadway Musicals but to also feature the unique music of the theater organ made for a spectacular evening of music.

The Prelude Chorus, featuring singers in grades 3-4, performed songs from The Lion King, Les Miserables and Annie; the Children's Chorus, featuring singers in grades 5-7, performed songs from Oliver, Cinderella, Annie, Oklahoma, The Sound of Music, Grease, and The Music Man. The Youth Chorus, featuring singers in grades 8-12; performed songs from Rent, Phantom of the Opera, The Music Man, Annie Get Your Gun, Hairspray, Wildcat, and Newsies.

An additional part of the evening was the ability to partner with Churchill's British Restaurant and Pub on the square. The Chorus reached out to them and created a unique opportunity for our concert to be promoted to the customers of Churchill's while we promoted the restaurant to the parents of our 100 member chorus. The way it worked was as follows: The Chorus provided Churchill's with discount coupons for any of their customers who purchased a ticket to our event. In turn Churchill's offered a 10% discount on any food item purchased by chorus family members on the night of the concert. May of our chorus families are not familiar with downtown McKinney. There was a 4:30 call time for chorus members to be at MPAC. Having a restaurant conveniently located, one that also offered a food discount, made a great partnership for the event.
