A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE DOWNTOWN PARKING COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDED LOCATIONS FOR POTENTIAL STRUCTURED PARKING FACILITIES AND A POTENTIAL MUNICIPAL FACILITIES COMPLEX

- WHEREAS, adequate public parking is important for the health and future growth of downtown McKinney; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney appointed a Downtown Parking Committee to study the parking needs for downtown McKinney; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council directed the Downtown Parking Committee to discuss long term and short term solutions to parking-related issues in downtown McKinney; and
- WHEREAS, the Downtown Parking Committee has developed recommendations for the locations of potential structured parking facilities and a potential municipal facilities complex which help to provide long term solutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby supports the following recommendations of the Downtown Parking Committee:
 - The City should conduct a study to determine the location of future city hall, looking at property east of Highway 5 as an option.
 - The Northeast and Southeast sectors of downtown, as shown in Exhibit A, should be considered for future structured parking.
 - Areas west of Kentucky Street should not be considered at this time for parking structures. Any consideration of these areas in the future should require structured parking to be appropriately scaled (shorter heights) and buffered from adjacent uses (protect residential uses to the west).
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
