A total of four (4) bidders submitted bid packages for the above referenced project on Friday, June 08, 2018. Of the four bids submitted, all four were read aloud and considered responsive. Bids were for the construction of approximately 6,800 LF of 8" WL with 1,300 LF installed by bore, 6,600 LF of 8" WW with 2,000 LF installed by static pipe burst, and associated pavement improvements. The four bids received are summarized below. A detailed bid tabulation is attached to this memo showing line item costs for each bid received.



Camino Construction, LP submitted the low bid of \$4,302,511. The full bid tabulation is included as an attachment to this letter. Camino Construction, LP is a contractor based out of Lewisville, Texas. Camino Construction, LP included a list of references with their bid package. Of the references contacted, all provided positive feedback and confirmed the quality of their work. One reference mentioned that they had an accelerated schedule on their project due to the construction impacting a hospital. The reference stated that Camino Construction was good about adapting to the accelerated schedule and completing the work in the time frame required.
