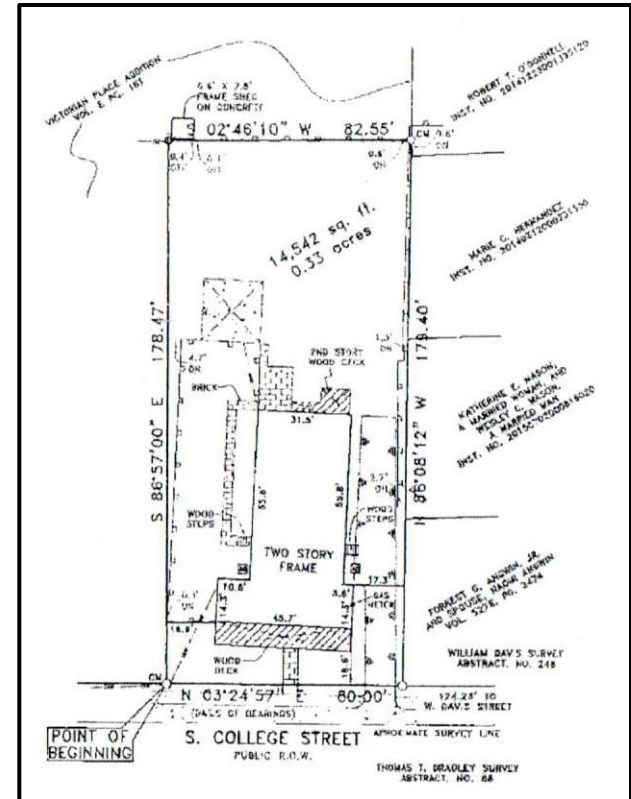

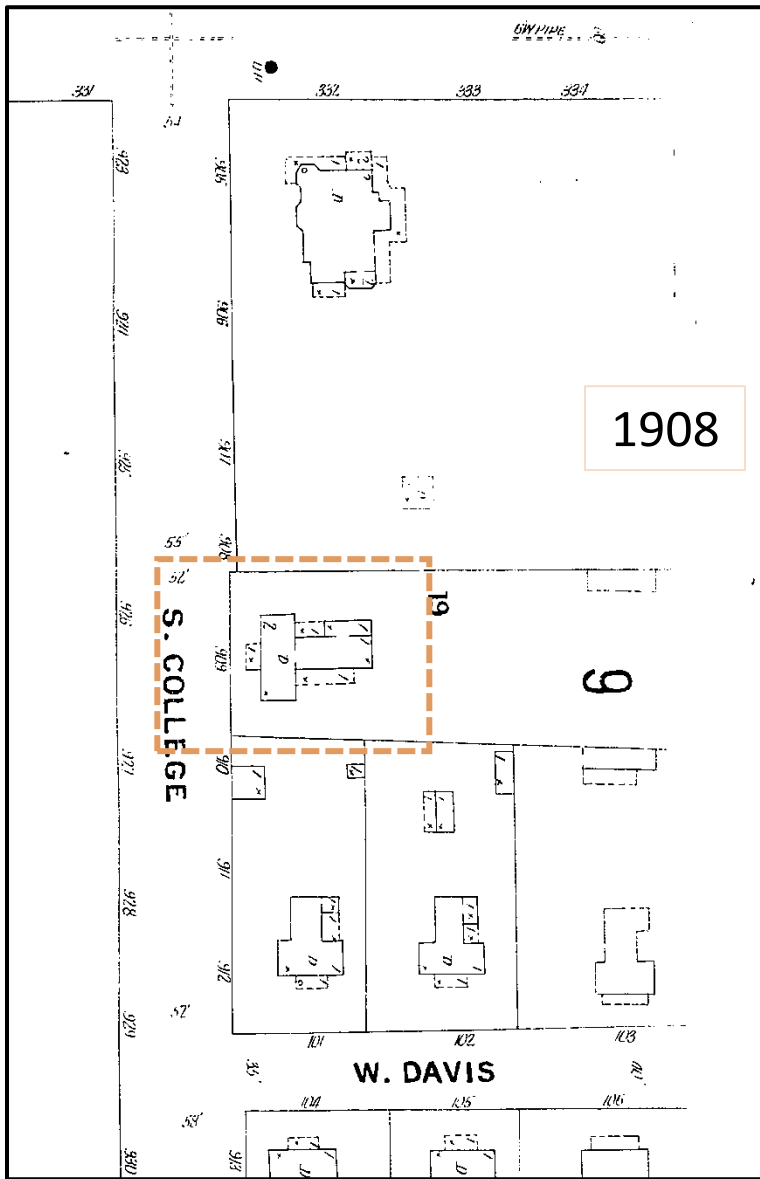
1898 photo showing Allen family; stayed in the Huffman-Allen family from 1918-1975

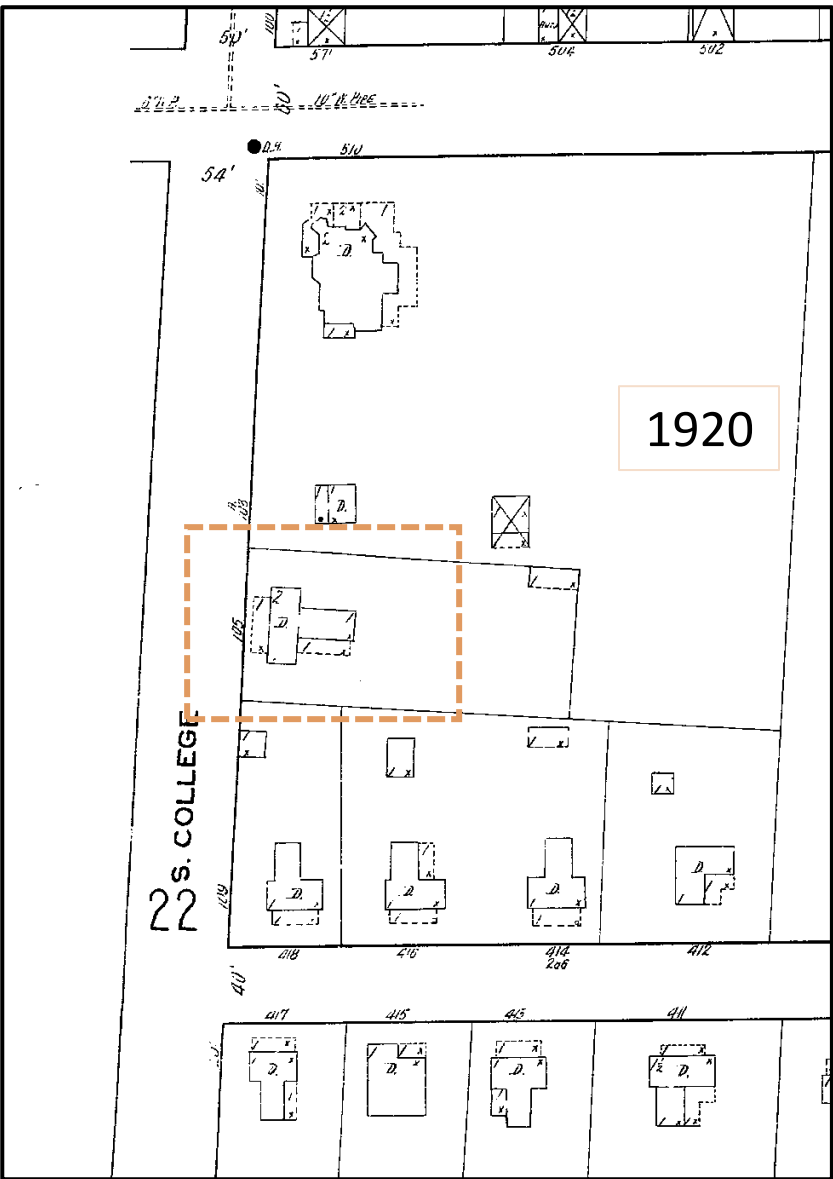

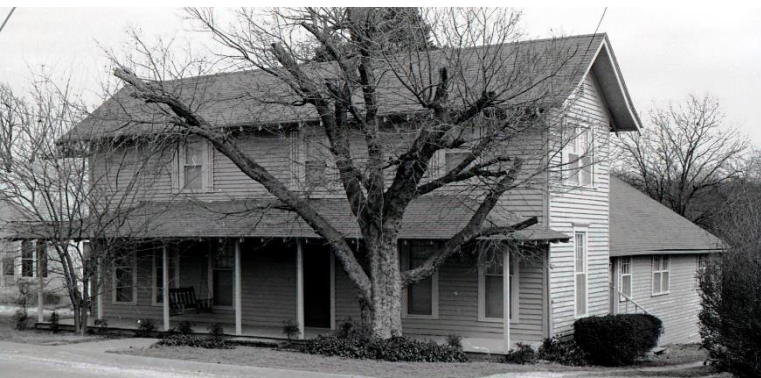
