

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-08-___ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, APPROVING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, FY 2023 (PY 2022) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager to make application for, accept and administer Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will review and confirm acceptance of providing CDBG funds and access under the program year to begin October 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Community Grants Advisory Commission held two public hearings and one public meeting to engage participation and prepared recommendations for Council acceptance of the Annual Action Plan, for the use of Community Development Block Grant funds in the next program year, including proposed FY 2022-23 allocation, amendments of previously approved CDBG and CDBG-CV fundings to continue to prevent, prepare, and respond to spread of the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, activities include public services, housing, community development and grant administration; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Action Plan providing CDBG funds for the program year effective October 1, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby adopts the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan with funding allocations as follows:
