

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-10-\_\_\_ (R)**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) FOR ENHANCEMENTS TO EXISTING POLICE SURVEILLANCE VAN**

**WHEREAS**, the UASI program focuses on enhancing regional security preparedness in major metropolitan areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the enhancements to the existing Police surveillance van will allow police officers to employ state of the art technology in order to protect the well-being of citizens and officers in surveillance situations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the UASI funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas approves the acceptance and implementation of the grant award of Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funding through the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) for enhancements to the existing Police surveillance van.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
