- **WHEREAS,** many corporate and non-profit organizations identify kindness as vital to their work culture and approach to success, and they promote these beliefs with activities and information, especially in the month of February, such as:
 - ★ Kindness.org considers kindness the "key to a better world"
 - ★ The Random Acts of Kindness (RAK) Day Foundation invites everyone to become a RAKtivist® and add to the unlimited amount of goodness that can be put into the world
 - ★ United Acts of Kindness Day by First United Bank encourages everyone to join in the goal of demonstrating one hundred thousand (100,000) kind acts this February 17; and
- **WHEREAS,** scientific studies suggest that kindness improves the well-being of school aged children, reduces stress and social anxiety, makes leaders more affective, influences happiness, and is contagious and compounding, and
- **WHEREAS,** kindness is attributed to building unity and dismantling conflict, through compassion and service rather than force; and
- **WHEREAS,** it is beneficial for us all to be intentionally and voluntarily kind toward one another not only when it is easy, but even more so when it is hard; and
- WHEREAS, everyone can be kind even the smallest acts have the greatest impact.
