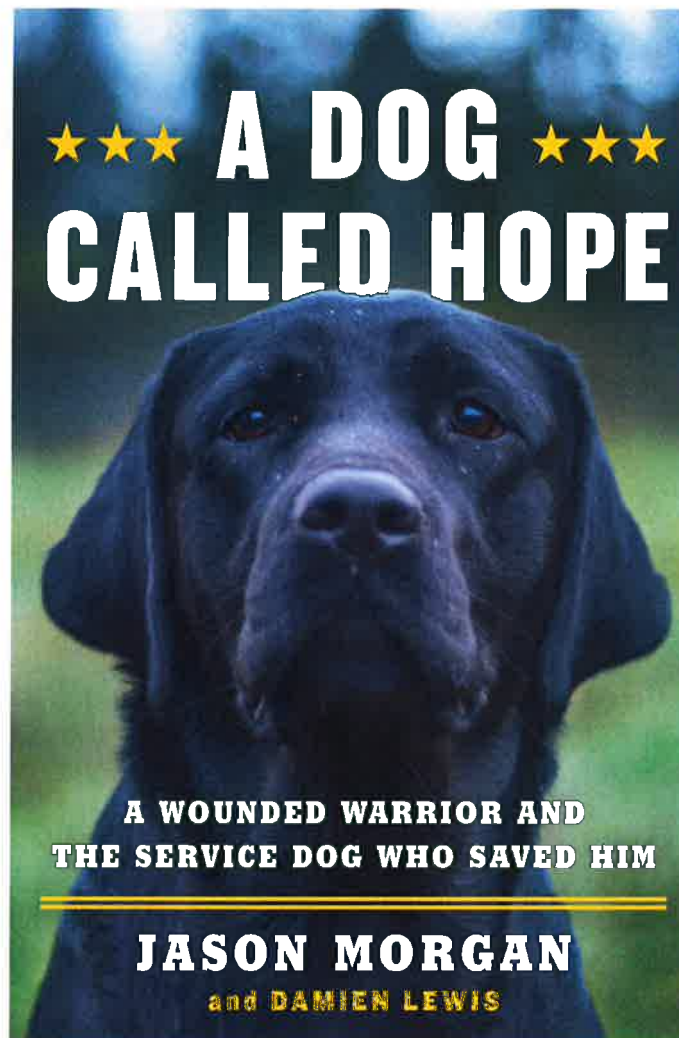

Staff Sergeant Jason Morgan is a best-selling author of *"A Dog Called Hope: The Special Forces Wounded Warrior and the Dog Who Dared to Love Him."*

Jason is also a motivational speaker who inspires corporate, faith-based, and not-for-profit audiences not only through recounting his remarkable journey — from the Special Forces to living as a wounded veteran, a Paralympic athlete, and a national speaker — but also by providing a roadmap for anyone navigating back from adversity.

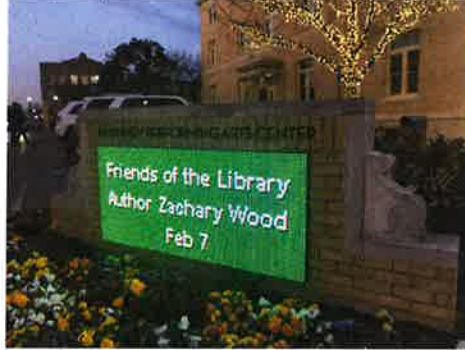
Enlisting in the Air Force in 1989 as part of the 10th Combat Weather Squadron, Jason completed Air Force Weather School before joining the elite Special Operations Aviation Regiment - a unit within the Green Berets - as a combat meteorologist.

After his injury, he participated in the Warrior Games, a competition for wounded and injured service members and veterans, for which he won numerous national awards.

Recently he has been an ardent spokesperson for the training of service dogs to enhance the lives of individuals with disabilities through his association with Canine Companions for Independence.

August 20, 2018:

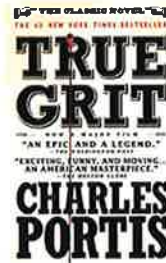
Nella Phillips presents *My Lucky Life* by Dick Van Dyke

September 17, 2018:

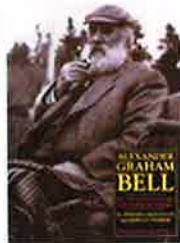
Gayle Brink presents *True Grit* by Charles Portis
