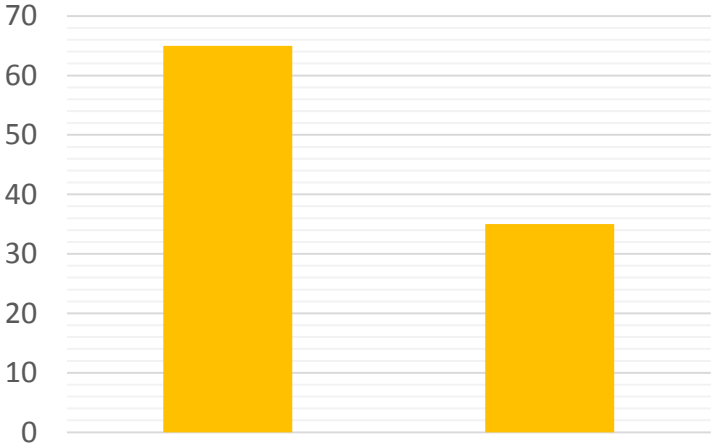
SRC Purpose is to offer recreation opportunities to persons 50 years of age and older through opportunities that promote socialization, health and wellness, and educational learning.

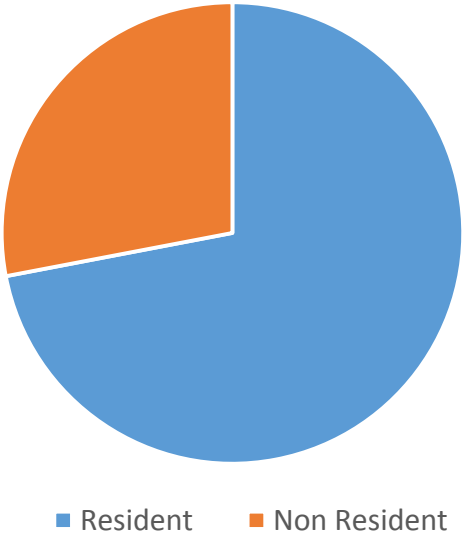
Current Membership Demographics

- Male: 35%

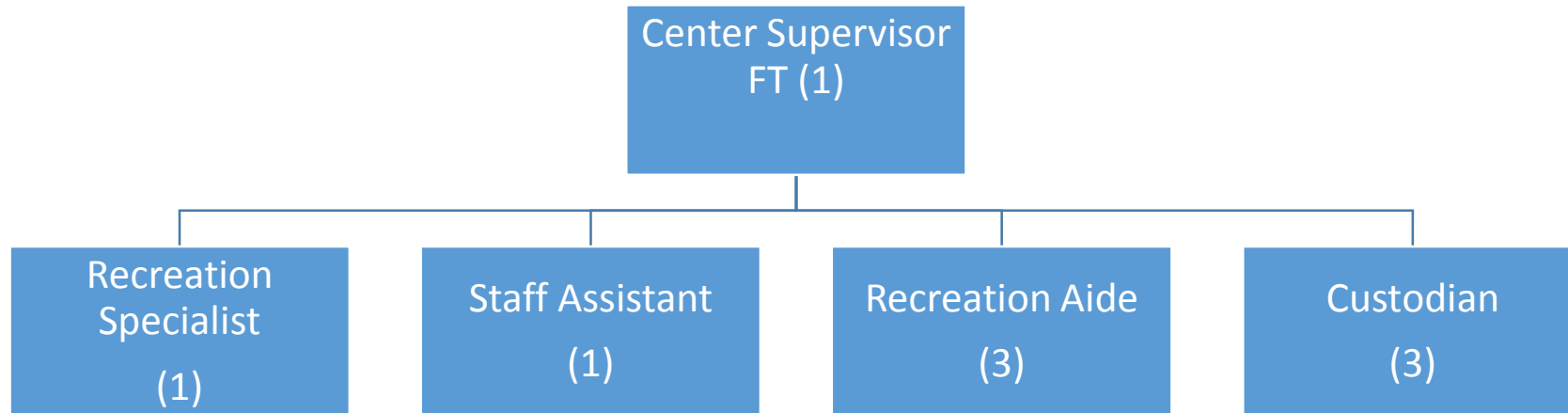
Female to Male

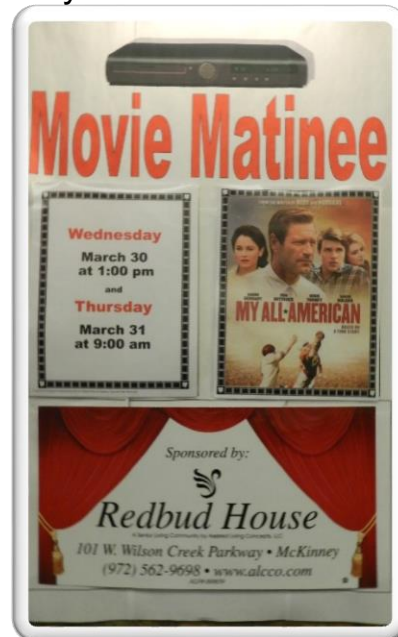
