

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-10-____ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,500 WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR LANES 3 AND 4 OF TRINITY FALLS PARKWAY FROM LAUD HOWELL PARKWAY EXTENDING APPROXIMATELY 1,500 FEET EAST AND AUTHORIZING ANY SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS UNDER SAID CONTRACT UP TO THE AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF SAID SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS, OF \$90,000

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, has authorized an Agreement with Castle Hills Partners, the developer of the Trinity Falls Municipal Utility District, by which Castle Hills Partners will construct Trinity Falls Parkway from the southern limits of their development (FM 543) south approximately 6,000 feet towards US 75; and

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney constructed the initial 2 lanes of Trinity Falls Parkway as part of the FM 543 Realignment Project, effectively named Laud Howell Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need for lanes 3 and 4 of Trinity Falls Parkway from Laud Howell Parkway to the terminus of the Castle Hills Partners project; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., for the design of Lanes 3 and 4 of Trinity Falls Parkway from Laud Howell Parkway extending approximately 1,500 feet east.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$80,500 as well as all required supplemental agreements thereto, with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., for the design of Lanes 3 and 4 of Trinity Falls Parkway from Laud Howell Parkway extending approximately 1,500 feet east for a total aggregate contract amount, inclusive of any supplemental agreements, not to exceed \$90,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
