

**The Heritage Guild of Collin County owns and operates Chestnut Square Historic Village. Located on 2 blocks at Chestnut, Anthony, Davis & Hwy 5, Chestnut Square is home to 6 historic houses, including the oldest house in McKinney, a general store, the former Foote Baptist Church, a house refurbished for receptions, and a reproduction of the Wilmeth one room Schoolhouse. We are the only historic park in Collin County not owned by the taxpayers.**


