

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-11-\_\_\_\_ (R)**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A REQUEST FOR A STUDY OF NECESSARY IMPROVEMENTS ALONG THE US 75 HIGHWAY CORRIDOR**

**WHEREAS,** US 75 carries more traffic than any other major highway into or out of the DFW Metroplex; US 75 just north of I-635 carries 275,000 vehicles per day and the roadway with the second highest traffic count is I-35 just north of I-635, with 204,000 vehicles per day; and

**WHEREAS,** the I-35 Corridor Segment 1 Committee is completing their report and one of the recommendations will be to conduct a separate study of the improvements that need to be completed on US 75 to carry the already tremendous and ever-increasing volume of traffic; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of McKinney has been requested to pass a resolution of support for said study of the US 75 Highway corridor, similar to that being performed for the I-35 corridor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby supports a request for a study of necessary improvements along the US 75 highway corridor.
