## Numbers

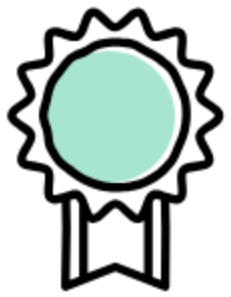
Adult program attendance saw an increase of 161% in attendance!

We visited the McKinney Coffee Company to share some rainy day reads

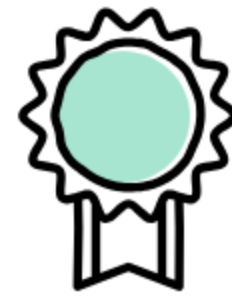

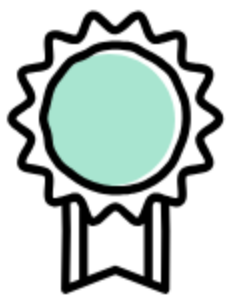
## Checkouts

**Circulation** continued to increase year over year, driven by a 23% growth in digital materials checkouts.



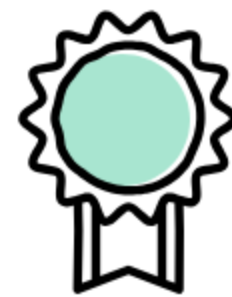
## Visitors

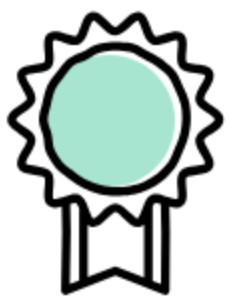
## ILL Dept.

**Interlibrary** Loan department shipped out 125 items to fulfill requests at other libraries- a 525% increase from last year- while receiving 416 items for McKinney residents- or 3% more.



## Computer Use

**RHH** had a 12% increase in PC sessions, 2,559, but JJGL had 4% fewer computer sessions this year, at 2,234, which led to a 4% overall increase.



## New Items

**We added** an average of 115 new items per day during the month of April- with a large growth in picture books with multiple copies of all the Texas 2x2 Award list titles.
