AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN UNIMPROVED PORTION OF AN EAST/WEST ALLEY (APPROXIMATELY 0.17 ACRES), LOCATED BETWEEN FRANCIS STREET AND BYRNE STREET, AND APPROXIMATELY 155 FEET SOUTH OF HILL STREET, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF

- WHEREAS, the owners of the properties immediately adjacent to the unimproved portion of an east/west alley, approximately 0.17 Acres, located between Francis Street and Byrne Street and approximately 155 feet south of Hill Street, in the City of McKinney, Collin County, Texas, have petitioned the City of McKinney to vacate said right-of-way; and
- WHEREAS, after due notice was sent to all persons owning properties adjacent to such right-of-way and all persons affected thereby; and
- WHEREAS, after due notice and hearing held before the City Council of the City of McKinney, the City Council has determined and finds that the right-of-way is not needed for travel by the general public, and that the same should be abandoned.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE **CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**


- The unimproved portion of an east/west alley, approximately 0.17 acres, Section 1. located between Francis Street and Byrne Street and approximately 155 feet South of Hill Street, in the City of McKinney, which is more fully depicted in Exhibit A and Exhibit B, attached hereto, is hereby closed and abandoned for public travel.
- Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
