Dear Mr. Chaffin:

In December 2010, the City of McKinney was awarded funding through the Clean Fleets North Texas August 2010 Call for Projects. As the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) and the City of McKinney continue to coordinate execution of the Agreement, issued electronically on January 28, 2011, NCTCOG requests the City of McKinney to begin implementation of Scope Activities outlined in the Agreement.

This letter shall serve as a Notice to Proceed, effective February 1, 2011, for this project. The City of McKinney may begin incurring expenses to convert three (3) light-duty hybrid-electric vehicles to plug-in hybrid-electric vehicles (PHEVs). The City of McKinney may seek reimbursement from NCTCOG for project expenses, consistent with the terms of the pending Agreement. Reimbursement for scope activity expenses shall not exceed \$38,646. NCTCOG will not provide reimbursement until the Agreement is fully executed.
