A RESOLUTION OF THE PARKS, RECREATION, AND OPEN SPACE ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, RECOMMENDING TO THE CITY COUNCIL TO REJECT ANY ORDINANCE, STUDY, OR TEMPORARY REGULATIONS THAT WOULD RESTRICT USAGE OF CITY OWNED PARKS

- WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Advisory Board desires to allow the continued and unrestricted usage of all City parks to the residents of McKinney; and
- WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Advisory Board finds that restricting the usage of City owned parks adjacent to schools would be unreasonably restrictive to the residents of McKinney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARKS, RECREATION, AND OPEN SPACE ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Advisory Board recommends that the City Council reject any ordinance, study, or other temporary regulation that would restrict usage of city owned parks during school hours to students of schools located near or adjacent to the park.
- Section 2. That the Park, Recreation and Open Space Advisory Board recommends, to the extent an actual or potential danger is shown to exist at a park, that the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Department and other city departments work with the McKinney ISD to identify remedies or procedures other than closing the parks during school hours that could be utilized to better ensure the safety of students using the parks during school hours while not unreasonably restricting usage of city parks by the public.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
