WHEREAS, as required by the City Charter, the City Manager has prepared an amendment to certain appropriations and expenditures/expenses in the 2013-2014 Budget and the 2014-2018 Capital Improvements Program and submitted same to the City Council for its approval and a true and correct copy is attached

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. Pursuant to the City Charter requirements of the City of McKinney, Texas in the fiscal year 2013-2014 Budget Amendment as attached is hereby authorized and approved.
- Section 2. The budget for the rehabilitation of Natural Resources Conservation Service Site 2A in the East Fork above Lavon watershed (Project DR7158) shall be amended by appropriating \$917,318 from the drainage construction fund balance and appropriating NRCS Grant funding in the amount of \$3,012,750.
- Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
