ITEM SUMMARY:

- This resolution authorizes the City Manager to execute a Special Warranty Deed with local taxing entities (McKinney ISD, Collin County and Collin County Community College) in the disposition of tax-delinquent vacant residential property held by all taxing entities located at Lot 13 and Lot 14 of the Underwood Addition.
- The City of McKinney has received an offer from Safari Development, LLC to purchase Lot 13 and Lot 14 of the Underwood Addition.
- A Special Warranty Deed prepared by City tax attorneys Gay, McCall, Isaacks, Gordon & Roberts, P.C., begins the process for disposition of tax-delinquent property held by all taxing entities.
- All the other taxing entities have approved the sale of this property.
- These properties were acquired having been "struck off" to the taxing entities subsequent to a Sheriff's sale.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

 The sale of these properties is in accordance with the Land Disposition Policy directed and approved by City Council on December 2, 2003.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

 The Housing Services Division agrees to participate in the sale of the above mentioned properties at a price not less than the combination of court costs, Constable fees, and cost of publication notices which total \$0 (these fees were paid in full with a previous sale of lots that were part of the same judgment) and an amount not greater than \$2,390.00.
