

Parks Maintenance Report to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Board October 9, 2015

- Parks crews started work on tree trimming projects. Recent parks completed are Carey Cox, McKissick, Ledbetter, Winniford and some at E.A. Randles. Future parks will be Inspiration, Ash Woods, Cottonwood and Eubanks.
- Our fall pre-emergent will be applied early this month. Athletic fields and selected parks and medians will be treated. We are still spot spraying for the fall grassy weeds you see coming in.
- Fall 2014 athletic league numbers are attached as well as previous seasons.
- We were approved for additional funding through MCDC for (2) pieces of equipment that will help increase our production without increasing our employee numbers. We are ordering a 5cu. yd. Mulch Blower to apply mulch to plant beds and to the dog park and also to blow engineered wood fibar into the play structure areas. Also funded was a riding athletic field paint striper which will allow for faster painting of all of the 30 soccer fields, flag football fields and all baseball and softball field foul lines.
