

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03-_____ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, DETERMINING A PUBLIC NECESSITY TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN PROPERTY (IN FEE SIMPLE) FOR PUBLIC USE BY EMINENT DOMAIN ASSOCIATED WITH THE MUNICIPAL COMPLEX PROJECT AND SAID CERTAIN PROPERTY IS IDENTIFIED AS BLOCK 7 LOTS 10B, 11B & 12B OF THE H&TC RAILROAD ADDITION AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF MCKINNEY AND MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS 208 MAIN STREET AND GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF MAIN STREET NORTH OF EAST VIRGINIA STREET; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR ACQUIRING THE PROPERTIES (IN FEE SIMPLE), AND TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO ACQUIRE THE NEEDED PROPERTY RIGHTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, has determined that a public need and necessity exists for the Municipal Complex Project, generally located to the East of Highway 5 in the vicinity of the Flour Mill. The location of the property identified as Block 7, Lots 10B, 11B and 12B in the H&TC Railroad Addition, an Addition to the City of McKinney and more commonly known as 208 Main Street is generally set forth in the map attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered this project and has determined that a public necessity exists for the acquisition of Property (in fee simple), as described on Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes ("Property").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS:

- Section 1. All of the above premises to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council, and they are hereby approved, ratified and incorporated into the body of this resolution as if copied in their entirety.
- Section 2. That the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute documents, as needed, to acquire the necessary Property for the Municipal Complex Project.
- Section 3. That the City Council hereby finds and determines that a public use and necessity exists for the City of McKinney for the Municipal Complex Project and to acquire the Property deemed necessary for the project, together with all necessary appurtenances, additions and improvements on, over, under, and through that certain lots tracts or parcels of land described in Exhibits B.

Section 4. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to negotiate for and to acquire the required Property for the City of McKinney, and to acquire said rights in compliance with State and Federal law. That the City Manager is specifically authorized and directed to do each and every act necessary to acquire the needed Property including, but not limited to, the authority to negotiate, give notices, make written offers to purchase, prepare contracts, to designate a qualified appraiser of the Property to be acquired when such appraisal is necessary and, where necessary, the use of Eminent Domain to condemn the Property.

Section 5. That the City Manager, or any individual he may so designate, is appointed as negotiator for the acquisition of the Property and, as such, the City Manager is authorized and directed to do each and every act and deed hereinabove specified or authorized by reference, subject to the availability of funds appropriated by the City Council for such purpose. That the City Manager is specifically authorized to establish the just compensation for the acquisition of the Property. That, if the City Manager or his designee determines that an agreement as to damages or compensation cannot be reached, then the City Attorney or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to file or cause to be filed, against the owners and interested parties of the subject Property, proceedings in eminent domain to acquire the above-stated interest in the Property.

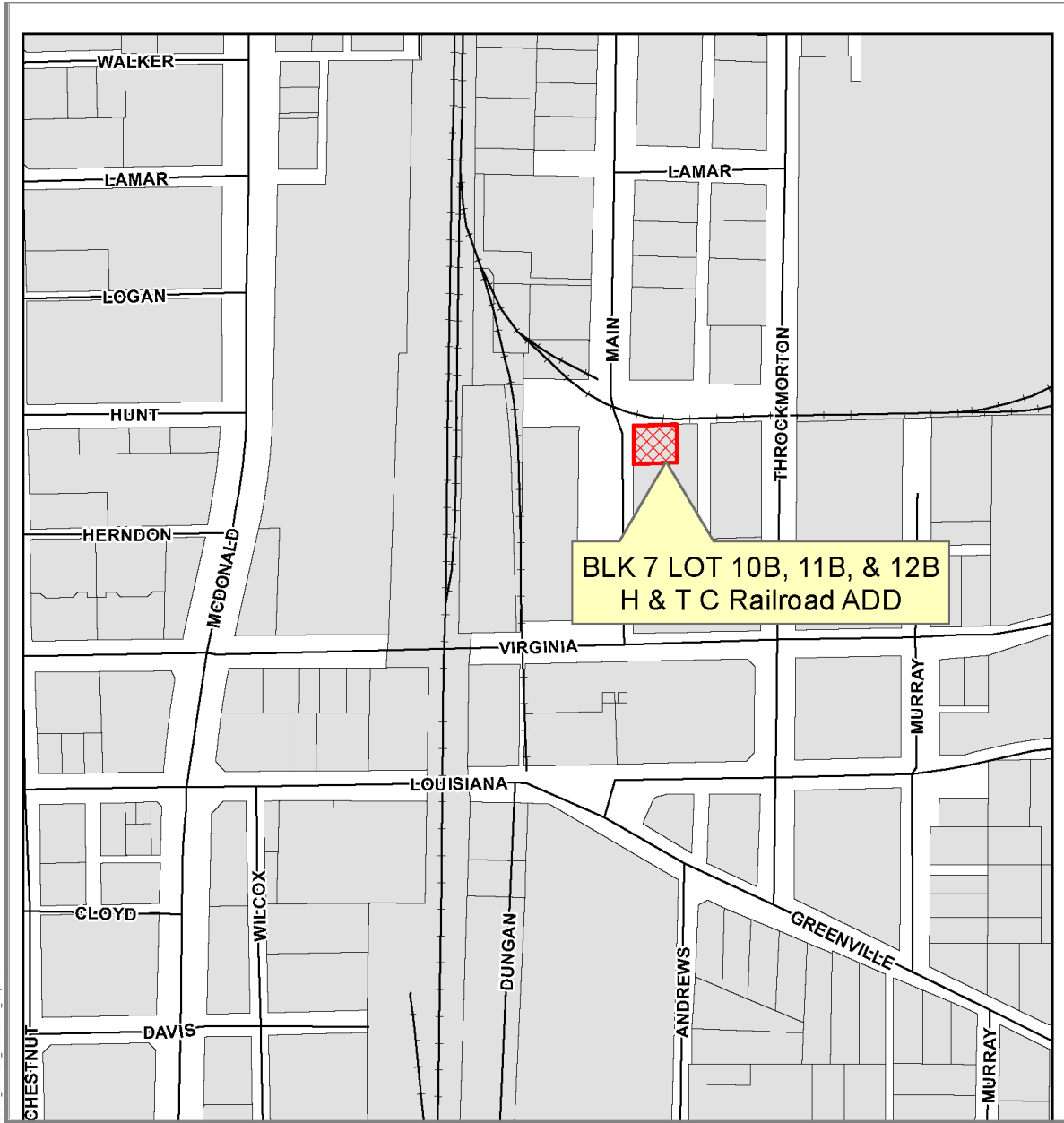

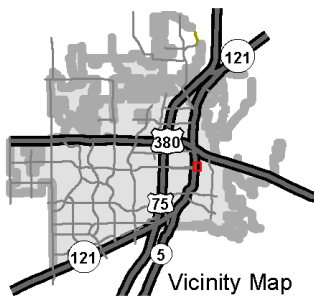

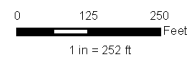
EXHIBIT "A" Location Map
