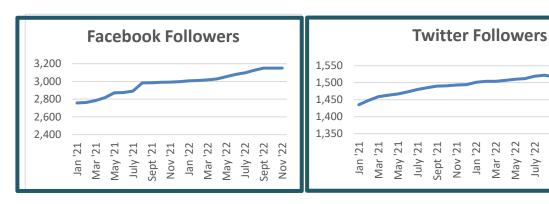

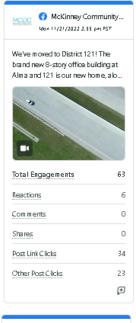
Social Media: Facebook and Twitter

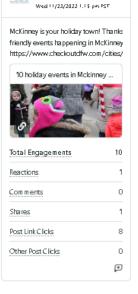

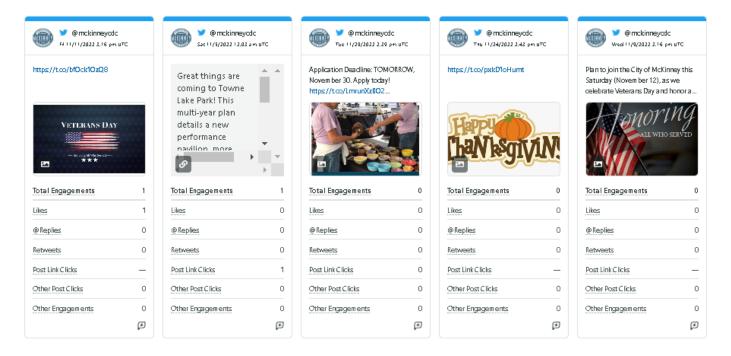
