A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, SUPPORTING A CORRIDOR STUDY FOR US 75 FROM IH 635 TO SH 121 (SAM RAYBURN TOLLWAY) IN DALLAS AND COLLIN COUNTIES TO IDENTIFY ALTERNATIVES AND SOLUTIONS TO ADDRESS MOBILITY NEEDS IN THE CORRDIOR AND TO MINIMIZE IMPACTS IN THE STUDY AREA AND REQUESTING THAT THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION EXTEND THE LIMITS OF THE CORRIDOR STUDY TO TELEPHONE ROAD

- WHEREAS, US 75 currently carries 220,000 vehicles per day at Midpark Drive in the City of Richardson and 105,000 vehicles per day at Bethany Drive in the City of Allen; and
- WHEREAS, by 2035, traffic demand is expected to increase to 420,000 vehicles per day at Midpark Drive in the City of Richardson and 325,000 vehicles per day at Bethany Drive in the City of Allen; and
- WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation must analyze all feasible and prudent transportation alternatives within the study area to evaluate their viability; and
- WHEREAS, the development of a preferred alternative will work to provide consistency with local, regional, state, and national transportation goals and with strategies to find and finance the project; and
- WHEREAS, continued growth in Collin, Grayson, and Fannin Counties, as well as increasing regional traffic along the US 75 corridor, will increase traffic on US 75 through McKinney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City of McKinney supports a corridor study for US 75 from IH 635 to SH 121 (Sam Rayburn Tollway) in Dallas and Collin Counties to identify alternatives and solutions to address mobility needs in the corridor and to minimize impacts in the study area.
- Section 2. The City of McKinney requests that the Texas Department of Transportation extend the limits of the corridor study to Telephone Road.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
