- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need for the application for and acceptance of federal funds, allocated to the City of McKinney in the amount of \$60,637 to be Used for Eligible Expenses, in Response to the COVID 19 Pandemic.
- **WHEREAS,** the Coronavirus Emergency Supplement Funding (CESF) Program, Justice Assistance Grant, funds are allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, to respond to the effects of the Coronavirus.
