

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONES AND CROSSWALKS FOR REEVES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND MODIFY THE REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONES DUE TO THE NEW ATTENDANCE BOUNDARIES FOR PROSPER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT IN MCKINNEY, TEXAS; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 314, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-314. Reeves Elementary School – Zone Designated.

The Reeves Elementary School zone shall be:

(1) On Auburn Hills Parkway beginning a point 225 feet south of Redbridge Lane and extending northwestward along Auburn Hills Parkway to a point 210 feet west of Reading Drive.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 314.1, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-314.1 Same – Speed.

The speed limit for the vehicles traveling the streets within the Reeves Elementary School zone during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 2:35 p.m. to 3:35 p.m., school days, shall be 20 miles per hour maximum.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 314.2, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-314.2 Same – Crosswalks.

The crosswalks shall be established at Reeves Elementary School as follows:

(1) At the intersection of Auburn Hills Drive and Redbridge Lane.
(2) At the intersection of Auburn Hills Drive and Reading Drive.

Section 4. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby repeals Section 62-329 (4) and Section 62-329 (5) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, after all the necessary signs and markings have been installed, and it is accordingly so ordained.

Section 6. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).
