ORDINANCE NO. 2011-02-00_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION FOR MAY 14, 2011, TO ELECT THREE COUNCIL MEMBERS; DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES; APPOINTING THE EARLY VOTING CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE AND PUBLICATION OF THE ELECTION

- WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of McKinney, Texas as adopted on December 31, 1959, and amended on November 8, 1971, January 15, 1977, May 7, 1988, and May 5, 2001 requires that an election for a Council member At-Large, Council member for District 2, and Council member for District 4 be held; and,
- WHEREAS, this Charter requires the three (3) Council members be elected for three (3) year terms, the Council members from District 2 and District 4 to be elected from the single-member Council Districts in which they reside by resident voters of those districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS:

- Section 1. That a general election is hereby ordered to be held on Saturday, May 14, 2011, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, and Chapter III of the City Charter of McKinney, Texas as amended.
- Section 2. That an election be held for the purpose of electing a Council member At-Large, a Council member for District 2, and a Council member for District 4 for three-year terms as prescribed by the City Charter.
- Section 3. That candidates for the Council member positions may file for one of the three (3) positions beginning on February 12, 2011 and until 5:00 p.m. on March 14, 2011.
- Section 4. The polling places are identified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part hereof for all purposes. The election officers and maximum number of clerks for each polling place shall be determined and appointed in accordance with the provisions of an election services contract to be executed with the Collin County Elections Administrator.
- Section 5. That the method of voting to be used in the general election on Saturday, May 14, 2011, be touch screen devices with Diebold's ACCUVOTE TS R6v.4.5.2 direct recording devices (DRE's) for early voting and election day and optical-scan ballots with Diebold's ACCUVOTE OS ROM v.1.96.4 for early voting by mail.
- Section 6. That the Collin County Elections Administrator is hereby appointed Alternate Early Voting Clerk for the purpose of conducting early voting for the general election.
- Section 7. That early voting by personal appearance be conducted beginning Monday, May 2, 2011 and shall close on Tuesday, May 10, 2011. During the lawful early voting by personal appearance period (May 2, 2011, through May 10, 2011), Collin County Elections Administrator shall keep the designated early voting polling places open for early voting as follows:

Monday, May 9	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 8. That the official canvass, by the City Council, will be held on

Monday, May 23, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber.

Section 9. That this Ordinance shall be published at least one (1) time, not

more than thirty (30) days nor less than ten (10) days before the

election in the McKinney Courier Gazette.

Section 10. That a copy of this Ordinance be posted on the bulletin board used

for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council at least

twenty-one (21) days before election day (April 25, 2011).

Section 11. That a copy of this Ordinance be delivered to the Collin County

Clerk not later than the 60th day before election day.

Section 12. That this Ordinance and all other related documents be printed in

both English and Spanish in accordance with all legal

requirements.
