RESOLUTION NO. 2010-11-____ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS ADOPTING A CITY COUNCIL POLICY PURSUANT TO ITS GOVERNANCE INITIATIVES PROVIDING THAT SEATED CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS REFRAIN FROM ENDORSING AND CAMPAIGNING FOR CANDIDATES IN LOCAL ELECTIONS

- WHEREAS, the City Council works cooperatively with other local governmental bodies having overlapping jurisdiction within the City of McKinney, including but not limited to, the McKinney Independent School District, Collin College and Collin County; and
- **WHEREAS**, supporting individual candidates may undermine and interfere with the City's initiative to maintain and improve working relationships with governmental bodies; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, as part of improving its governance initiative, desires to promote teamwork, cooperation and integrity among City Council members; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to avoid the appearance of disagreement among City Council members when supporting different political candidates; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council seeks to avoid the appearance that individual City Council members are endorsing one political candidate over another in local elections; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council has agreed to establish a policy recommending that sitting City Council members not endorse or campaign for other political candidates in local elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby adopts a governance initiative creating a policy whereby seated City Council members may not endorse or campaign for other political candidates in local elections (City, County, School District, Judges, and local representatives to State Legislature) through oral statements in a pubic forum or written materials intended for public dissemination.
