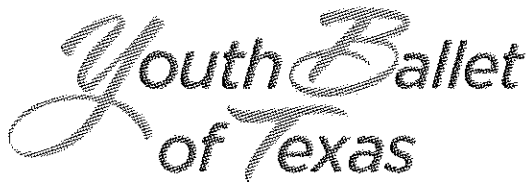

YBT's 2015-16 season was distinguished by our leap into the regional dance scene as an up and coming ballet company of merit. We had as a goal this year to reach out to the community in ways that would foster the growth of awareness of our company as a serious, pre-professional student company, and an arts organization committed to enriching the arts community of McKinney in particular. Evidence of our involvement in the McKinney arts scene is evident. A painting of one of our dancers hangs in the McKinney Public Library. Our dancers performed a Texas-inspired ballet for the Collin McKinney Birthday celebration. We had record attendance at this year's winter ballet *Krakatuk: A Nutcracker Prequel* at McKinney North High School. We brought in the professional faith-based ballet company, Ballet Magnificat! Alpha Company for a workshop in February, which was open to the local dance community. Three of our dancers were invited to the Ballet Magnificat! summer intensive this July. Our company dancers performed at *Dance Planet*, sponsored by the Dance Council of North Texas, a celebration of regional dance. They shared the stage with professional dance company, Dallas Black Dance Theatre, and our dances were very well received. Our *Spring Potpourri* performance included historical ballets from the late 19th century, and more recent works in an evening of dance for everyone at Faubion Middle School. The performance was well-received and well-attended. As the reputation of Youth Ballet of Texas grows, we owe our thanks and sincere gratitude to the community businesses who contributed to the company through program ads, and most definitely to the Arts Commission for their generosity.
