



## By the Numbers


The number of items checked out in May was the highest total for any May on record for the library system thanks to the continued growth of eBooks. JJGL also saw the highest total on record, surpassing May 2019.




Including renewals, total circulation is still below peak levels of May 2019, but the chart below highlights the impact of extending the check out period to 3 weeks.




May program attendance was down compared to pre-pandemic levels, but John and Judy Gay saw an increase in program attendance vs. 2019.



The number of unique cardholders who checked out at least one item in May is the highest total ever for that month. Our digital borrower population continues to grow, but so does the borrower population at JJGL.



Public Computer use still has yet to reach pre-covid levels. However, we have recently received reporting on Wifi use at JJGL and discovered that library PCs only account for 40% of library public internet use, so we actually provided internet services to 4,357 users at JJGL in May.



Study Rooms were reserved for a total of 1,031 hours in the month of May, a 50% increase over May 2021. All of the grown occurred at RHH.
