

TAX INCEREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBER ONE (TIRZ1)

OCTOBER 4, 2021

The Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number One (TIRZ1) Board of the City of McKinney, Texas met in regular session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas on Tuesday, October 4, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.

Board Chair Charlie Philips called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m. upon determining a quorum consisting of himself and the following members were present: Board Vice Chair Frederick Frazier, and Members George Fuller, Rainey Rogers, Justin Beller, Geré Feltus, Rick Franklin, Bry Taylor, and Darrell Hale

There were approximately seventy-five (75) members in attendance.
