A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT AN URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) PROGRAM GRANT AWARD FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) TO PURCHASE A LAW ENFORCEMENT VIRTUAL REALITY TRAINING SIMULATOR FOR THE MCKINNEY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

- **WHEREAS,** the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the importance of enhancing regional security and emergency preparedness; and
- **WHEREAS**, the State Homeland Security Priority Action plan identifies the need to increase the capability of the state's response system to minimize damage and loss of life from terrorist and criminal attacks and natural and technological disasters; and
- WHEREAS, the grant award will be used to fund the purchase of a Virtual Reality Training Simulator for the McKinney Police Department that addresses the need for enhanced scenario-based de-escalation training and critical incident responses; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the UASI funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor (OOG) in full; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the City Manager as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the agreement on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section #1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the acceptance and implementation of the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant award through the Office of the Governor (OOG) to fund the purchase of a Virtual Reality Training Simulator for the McKinney Police Department.
- Section #2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage, and it is so resolved.
