## McKinney Arts Commission Final Grant Report Narrative, April 2017

### **Annual Christmas Tree Lighting – November 25, 2016**

For the fourth year, the Children's, Prelude, and Youth Choruses performed for this event, with 75+ singers, grades 3-12. Chorus families from all over Collin County also were brought to downtown McKinney and enjoyed the holiday festivities before and after the tree lighting at the Home for the Holidays festival. This brought exposure to the Chorus to a large audience and created a performance venue that helped us accomplish our goal of providing value to the community.

### **Red, White, and Blue: A Salute to America – February 24, 2017**

Our Prelude and Children's Choruses presented an evening of patriotic music in the McKinney Performing Arts Center on the Square. We partnered with the Heritage Drum and Fife Corps and local fiddler, Rob Flickenger, for a night of celebrating our wonderful country. We provided free tickets for all veterans in attendance, and ended the performance with a Salute to the Armed Forces.

### **Arts in Bloom – April 8, 2017**

The Prelude and Children's Chorus joined the festivities of the day by performing on the east side of the MPAC. They sang a variety of music, including folk tunes, patriotic, and pop tunes. Before and after their performance, they enjoyed visiting the various vendors and activities, and interacting with other townspeople. Several stayed for lunch on the square. It was an enjoyable time for our Chorus families to experience the city of McKinney.
